MEDIA RELEASE Juvenile Assault Arrest

On 8/8/24 at about 7:08PM, Ithaca Police Officers responded to the 200 block of Elmira Road for a dispute in progress. Prior to arrival, the caller reported multiple juveniles attacking another juvenile.

Upon Officers arrival, scene investigation determined that 2 juveniles under the age of eighteen assaulted the victim, including using a machete. Said victim sustained non-life-threatening physical injury as a result of this attack.

The assailants fled the area and were stopped by police in the 200 block of South Meadow Street. A machete was recovered. The juvenile assailants, aged 15 and 17, were both detained and transported to the Ithaca Police Department.

Both juveniles were later released to the custody of their parents with multiple charges pending. Their identities will not be released.
